- 1 The right to request a restriction to the use or disclosure of information.
- 2 The right to request an amendment or correction to the medical record.
- 3 The right to inspect and copy the medical record.
- 4 The right to request an accounting of disclosures for non-treatment, non-payment, and non-healthcare operations (non-TPO).
- 5 The right to receive a Notice of Privacy Practice (NPP).
- 6 The right to request confidential communications.

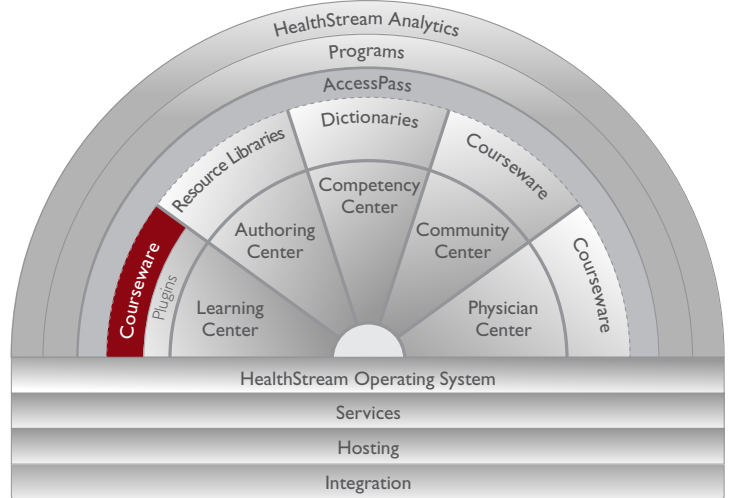
