- Loosen the soiled dressing.
- Remove the gauze slowly, moistening it with sterile normal saline solution, if needed.
- Observe the dressing for the amount, type, color, and odor of drainage, and discard the dressing and gloves in a waterproof trash bag.

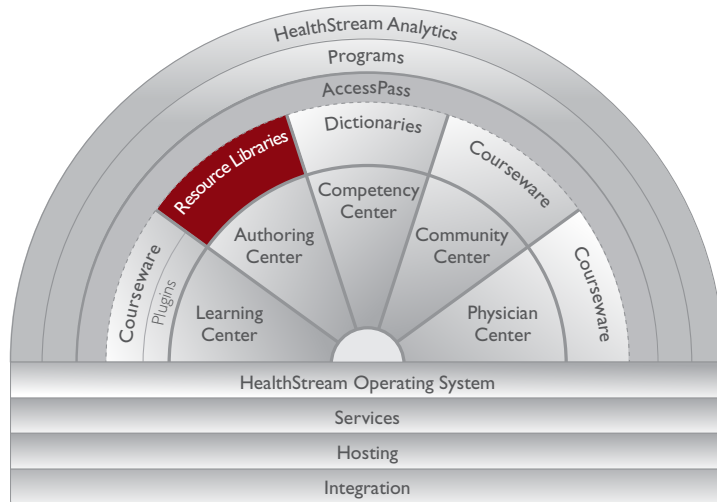
